



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

APRON FRONT UNDERMOUNT STAINLESS STEEL SINKS

These instructions are for installing Transolid® apron front farmhouse style undermount stainless steel sinks. If you are installing another type of sink, such as a standard Undermount or Top mount (Drop-in) sink, please refer to instructions specifically for those sinks.

ATTENTION INSTALLER:

Transolid® recommends that all countertops be cut by an approved or certified installer and that the sinks be installed by the installer whenever possible. The countertop/sink unit ideally should be installed as one on the jobsite.

These installation instructions are for solid surface countertop materials. For information on installations in granite, marble, stone, quartz or butcher block countertops, contact your fabricator. For information on installation in ceramic tile countertops, contact your tile contractor.

Transolid® is not responsible for sink or countertop if damaged during installation.

Metal edges may be sharp - use caution when handling.

Remember, it is your responsibility to follow all local plumbing and building codes.

Inspect sink for damage prior to beginning installation. Do not install a damaged unit.

The warranty will be voided if these installation instructions are not followed.

Templates are supplied only as a guide. The physical use of the sink will ensure a more accurate cutout.

The instructions that follow are for installing a Transolid® apron front farmhouse style undermount stainless steel sink. Be sure to read all instructions completely before beginning installation.

transolid[®] INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS - UNDERMOUNT STAINLESS STEEL SINKS

Sink installation recommended for professional installers only.

1. Roughing In and Preparation


IMPORTANT! Before installing this sink, verify that the distance from the top of the cabinet to the top of the doors (A) is greater than the apron height (B).

Apply painter's tape to the cabinet to make cuts and to protect the cabinet surfaces when cutting.

Position the template on the front of the cabinet, flush with the top and centered left to right. Secure the template with tape.

Trace the template and remove.

Cut the cabinet along the traced line.




2. Installing Support Framing

NOTICE: For proper countertop installation, the top of the sink must not extend above the top of the cabinet.

Cut two lengths of support framing to extend horizontally along the inside walls on each side of the cabinet.

Measure and mark the support mounting locations; ensure the sink rim will sit at or slightly below the top of the cabinet.



Position and level the supports in position.

Use clamps to hold the supports in position. Secure the supports with construction adhesive and screws (not supplied).

Optional Vertical Supports

Cut four lengths of support framing to extend from the bottom of the horizontal supports to the floor of the cabinet. Secure the vertical supports with construction adhesive and screws (not supplied).

3. Make a Template and Cutouts

Use the sink itself as the template for the cutout on the countertop. Measure the location for the faucet and any accessories.

Center the sink, draw around it with a pencil, then make the cutout in the countertop. Cut along the inside of this line to provide opening.


Finish the inside of the sink cutout on the top according to the recommendations of the countertop material supplier.

4. Install the Sink

Lower the sink onto the supports; verify the sink is supported by the frame.

Push the sink in to ensure the apron is flush to the front of the cabinet.

Verify the sink is level; make any adjustments and shim as needed.




5. Install the Countertop

Clean the bottom of the countertop and top flange (or lip) of the sink with denatured alcohol. Then apply a narrow bead of high quality silicone adhesive sealant to the top edge of the sink flange.

Apply a bead of high quality silicone adhesive around the side and back of the sink.


Place the countertop on the sink.

Remove any excess sealant from the inside lip of the sink using a cleaner recommended by the sealant manufacturer and allow it to properly cure following sealant manufacturer's recommended instructions.



Install the faucet and strainers according to installation instructions.

Connect the trap to the strainers.



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Suggestions for the Care and Cleaning of Transolid® Stainless Steel Sinks

When it comes to maintenance, Transolid® recommends to be consistent in your cleaning. It is better to clean on a more frequent basis and avoid the need for heavy duty cleaning.

Make sure your sink is clean and dry when not in use. This is the best method of preventive maintenance. Keep the sink water spot free and shiny by rinsing and towel drying after every use.

Keep your sink clog free to prevent standing water which can lead to mineral deposit build up. If a mineral build up should occur, use a mixture of vinegar and hot water to remove the deposit.

Use a soft cloth and liquid detergent on a mirror finish deck. Do not use any abrasive materials on a mirror finish.

Clean stainless steel at least once a week.

Apply stainless steel cleaner/polish with a non-abrasive cloth or sponge, working with, not across, the grain.

Do not use steel wool, wire brushes or abrasive sponge pads. These will leave an iron residue that will eventually lead to rust and particles that will corrode the sink. Use only non-scratch cleaning pads.

Do not leave any steel or cast iron cookware in the sink for a long period of time. This may leave iron particles that will corrode the sink.

Anything left in the sink can trap moisture which will eventually lead to staining.

Cleaners containing chloride (bleach) are not recommended. If used, rinse the surface immediately to prevent corrosion.

Most stainless steel products will scratch from everyday use. However, these scratches will blend over time to create a unique finish.

Do not store open containers of cleaners or chemicals such as acids, bleach, sodium chloride, lye, toilet bowl cleaner, drain cleaner, or hard water stain removal products under your sink.

Success with cleaners and procedures is dependent upon such factors as the hardness and temperature of the water, using exact measurements of ingredients, changes in cleaning formulas and the condition of the product being cleaned. Since there are variations within these factors, Transolid® cannot guarantee the effectiveness of the formulas mentioned.

Care Tip

Allowing water to evaporate on metal will form water deposits. To avoid this and keep your product looking beautiful, it is important to wipe the sink clean with a soft cloth after each use.

Transolid® will replace without charge, (excluding labor & transportation costs) any stainless steel sink or fireclay sink supplied by Transolid® that is proven to be defective, with an equivalent replacement, within the specific appropriate period from date of purchase, to the original owner, provided it has been used solely in a residential application and installed in accordance with the Transolid® installation instructions, used and cleaned as recommended, and not damaged due to abuse, misuse, or negligence. For installed warranty concerns, please contact Transolid® directly for further information and proper documentation. In the event of a warranty claim, the owner will be required to provide proof of purchase in the form of sales receipt.

This warranty will not cover any damages which might be caused by the product. (Some states do not allow such limitation, so this reference may not apply to you.)

Transolid® reserves the right to inspect any sink reported to be defective prior to replacement of the sink. All decisions are final. Replacement cost EXCLUDES transportation and any labor costs for the removal or reinstallation.

Stainless steel is virtually carefree, but yet it can be dented, scratched and harmed by certain chemicals. Simple cleaning techniques and use of stainless grids can keep your sink looking great everyday.

Transolid® shall not liable in case of:

- Improper installation/modification
- Damages resulting from abuse, such as heavy impact or dropped objects
- Improper care or maintenance
- Improper applications (such as exposure to corrosive chemicals, photographic solutions, etc.)
- Any modifications made to the product after it left Transolid® premises

TRANSOLID® SUGERENCIAS PARA EL CUIDADO Y LIMPIEZA DE LOS FREGADEROS DE ACERO INOXIDABLE TRANSOLID®

Cuando se trata de mantenerlo, Transolid® recomienda que sea con sistema en su limpia. Es mejor limpiar sobre una base mas frecuente y evitar la necesidad de la limpieza pesada.

Algunas de las mejores formas de mantenerlo son:

- Utilice un paño suave y detergente líquido en un fregadero de acero inoxidable.
- Utilice una acumulación de minerales, use una mezcla de vinagre y agua para eliminar la estructura de los depósitos de hierro.
- Mantenga su fregadero libre de obstrucción para evitar el agua que fluye por el fregadero.
- Aplique el agua de limpiador / pulidor de acero inoxidable con un paño o una esponja no abrasiva, trabajando con un traves, del grano.
- Los depósitos que corren en residuo del hierro que condensó eventual al modo ya no se recomienda limpiar la superficie inmediatamente para evitar la corrosión.
- Si se usa, el jengibre que correña la superficie de limpiarán con el tiempo.
- La mayoría de los productos de acero inoxidable rayarán del uso diario.
- Las imágenes que quedan en el fregadero pude atrapar la humedad que eventualmente conducirá a manchas.
- No se recomienda limpiar la superficie que contiene cloruro (blanqueador).
- El agua de recipientes abiertos de limpiadores o productos químicos como las sales de marisco, lejía, cloro o de sodio, limpiador de hidrógeno, agua de estos frotadores, Transolid® no puede garantizar la efectividad de las frotadoras de este tipo.
- El agua que lleva una temperatura del agua, usando mediciones exactas como la dureza y temperaturas de procedimientos depende de factores tales de ingredientes, cambios en las formulaciones de limpieza dentro del estadio del agua. Para evitar esto y mantener su producto buscando hermoso, es importante que se evapore sobre el metal forma depositos de cada uso.



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Conectar la trama a los coladores de fregadero.

Instale los grifos y coladores de fregadero de acuerdo
erdo con las instrucciones de instalacion.

Retire el exceso de sellador del borde interior del
fregadero usando un limpiador recomendado por
el fabricante del sellador y permita que cure ade-
cuadamente sujetando las instrucciones recomen-
dadas por el fabricante del sellador.

Coloque el cordón en la parte superior del fregadero.


Aplique un cordón de adhesivo de silicona de alta
calidad alrededor del lado y la parte posterior del
fregadero.

Limpie el fondo del mostrador y la bridaj superiores o
labio) del fregadero con alcohol desnaturalizado. A
continuacin, aplique un cordón estrecho de adhe-
sivo de silicona de alta calidad en el borde superior
de la bridaj del fregadero.


Compruebe que el fregadero está nivelado; Hacer
cuadricular ajuste y llenar el espacio con calce como
sea necesario.

Empuje el fregadero hacia adentro para asegur
rase de que el panel frontal esté al ras de la parte
frontal del gabinete.

Baje el fregadero sobre los soportes; Verifique que
el fregadero esté soportado por el marco.



5. Instalar el contador



Termino el interior del fregadero cortado en la tapa según las recomendaciones del surtidor del material de la encimera.

Centrar el fregadero, dibujar alrededor de él con un lápiz, después hacer el corte en la encimera.

Utilice el fregadero como la plantilla para el área de corte real en la encimera. Mida la ubicación del grifo y de los accesorios.


3. Hacer una plantilla y recortes

Corte a lo largo del interior de esta línea para proporcionar la abertura.


Cortar el fregadero, dibujar alrededor de él con un lápiz, después hacer el corte en la encimera.

Utilice abrazaderas para sostener los soportes en su posición. Asegure los soportes con adhesivo de construcción y tornillos (no suministrados).

Coloque y nivele los soportes en posición.



Corte el gabinete a lo largo de la línea trazada.
